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☐ The green Priority Standard Worksheet (inventory).
☐ A typed/printed, professional letter (to me!) detailing each standard and
then pointing to where I will see evidence of your learning in your
attached portfolio.
☐ A portfolio (folder/ file) of documents to show as evidence of your
learning.
Sticky notes or labels to clearly identify each standard.

Other things to consider:

- For your professional letter, consider using your Mastery Unit 1 notes.
- You may use one document for more than one standard, but sticky notes or labels should clearly point to the different standards.
- You may photocopy or take a photo and then print of a piece of your work for your portfolio (for instance a portion of your Mice Project, or a page from your CRJ).
- You must have at least 6 different documents in total (that means that I don't want you to find evidence for all 9 standards in ONE document).
